### Clean up Australia Day 2011

Sunday March 6th is Clean up Australia Day for 2011. Officially 2011 is the 21st year of this campaign.

Cleanup Australia Day originally started as thought by one man, Australian builder and solo yachtsman, Ian Kiernan who wanted to have a cleaner Sydney Harbour.

Since then Clean Up Australia has evolved into an organisation that works with the community, government and business to provide practical solutions to help us all live more sustainably every day of the year.

In the past 20 years, Australians have devoted more than 24 million hours towards the environment through Clean Up Australia Day and collected over 200,000 tonnes of rubbish.

## *Maleny Rotary promotes regular bowel scans to prevent bowel cancer*

The Maleny Rotary Club is presently promoting better health by sponsoring the annual bowelscan programme.

Rotary Bowelscan programmes are run across Australia, with Bowelscan kits available now through the Maleny Rotary Club or Maleny Amcal Chemist.

## Maleny Wood Expo planning takes shape!

The Maleny Wood Expo - "From chainsaw to fine furniture" for 2011 will be held at the Maleny Showgrounds on April 30th and May 1st.

This event is run by Barung Landcare and the events aim is to showcase the work of the region's finest wood artisans and to promote sustainable timber use.

Organiser, Steve McLeish says, "Visitors can see the whole 'wood story' - from purchasing native timber tubestock and talking farm forestry to mobile milling and the end product, the finished furniture."

He continued that Barung Landcare has announced that The Wootha Prize competition is back again in 2011.

The winner of the Wootha Prize will receive \$1000 ash, a trophy and the option of a free site at the 2012 Maleny Wood Expo. The runner up will receive \$300 and

third place \$200.

In order to open the prize to more woodworkers, the 2011 Wootha Prize competition is not a themed competition. But all entries must have been made within the past two years, and must fit within a one metre square footprint with a maximum height of 2500mm.

Expressions of Interest for the Wootha Prize must be received by Barung Landcare no later than 1st March 2011, and successful applicants will be notified soon after.

## Mum's favourite Recipes



### Beef Burgers

- always a great easy Sunday night meal!

#### Ingredients

1kg minced beef - 1 small onion, chopped finely - 2 cloves garlic, chopped - 2 tblsp barbecue sauce - 2 tblsp Worcestershire sauce - 2 tblsp fresh parsley, chopped - 1/2 cup breadcrumbs - 1 egg, lightly beaten - 1 large onions, sliced - 6 slices cheese - 2 tomatoes, sliced - 6 bread rolls - 1/2 lettuce

#### Method

Put beef, small chopped onion, garlic, sauces, parsley, breadcrumbs and egg into large bowl and Mix until combined.

Shape mixture into 6 burger patties.

Cook burger patties on barbecue until browned on both sides, cook large sliced onion as well. Add sliced cheese to the top of burgers for 2 minutes or until melted.

Split and toast rolls, then add lettuce and tomato, burger patties with cheese and onion.

All funds raised from the evening go towards new facilities on the new sports and recreation precinct.



## Asian Honeybee

I have delivered a speech in the Australian parliament, urging the Government to fund an eradication programme for the Asian Honeybee, which has been found in North Queensland and has the capacity if not stopped to do widespread damage to the bee and honey industry and agriculture and horticulture generally.

Bees are not only about honey; in fact, that is a relatively small part of what they do. They are a key part of the ecological network and play a vital role in the reproduction of plants everywhere.

Without our bees, our agriculture and horticultural industries would be much worse off and probably risk complete collapse, and much of the pollination of our native plants would not occur.

I met with beekeepers in Canberra recently (2 March), including Maleny-based bee researcher Dr Max Whitten, to assist in drawing attention to the issue and help campaign to the Government for funds for an eradication programme.

## Milk Price War

I spoke in Parliament recently on the milk price war that has been underway between Coles and Woolworths.

While the lower prices are good for consumers in the short term, they

may have a negative impact over the longer term by harming smaller retailers who try to lower their prices to compete with the larger retailers and also the dairy industry, which fears the lower prices may result in lower prices for them at the farm gate.

Fearing a drop in the income they receive, many farmers are concerned that they will have no choice but to walk away from the dairy industry, an outcome we can't allow to happen because farming remains a valued industry, that provides employment and quality Australian produce, and it needs to be encouraged.

## Cyber Threats

Businesses operating in the financial and insurance sector are among the most sophisticated users of communications technology, yet there is scope for better security against cyber criminals, the Australian Institute of Criminology has found.

A report into cyber attacks on business, which highlights the need for better partnerships between government agencies and business to ensure security is maintained at the highest level, has been released by the AIC.
