The Rio Tinto Ride to Conquer Cancer is a 2-day bike ride, over 200 km up hill, wind against, it will be raining and I've only got a really old bike (similar to a BMX), throughout Queensland's scenic countryside.

I will be following thousands of other riders, keeping up the rear, riding 100 km, two days in a row. As you can imagine, riding that far is not going to be an easy, so will need all the help possible.

Bake pizza for 10 minutes or until golden.

Serve hot, garnished with rocket.

Maleny Ambulance called to another "chain saw" accident

At 6 p.m. on Thursday August 4th Maleny ambulance officer, Peter Griffey was called to Stanley River Road, Maleny where a person had been chain sawing trees on his property and it appears a tree or part of a tree fell causing injuries to that person.

The injured male person had gone to complete the work at about 4p.m. and was to return by 5p.m. When he did not return the ambulance was called and on the arrival of the ambulance the male person was found unconscious.

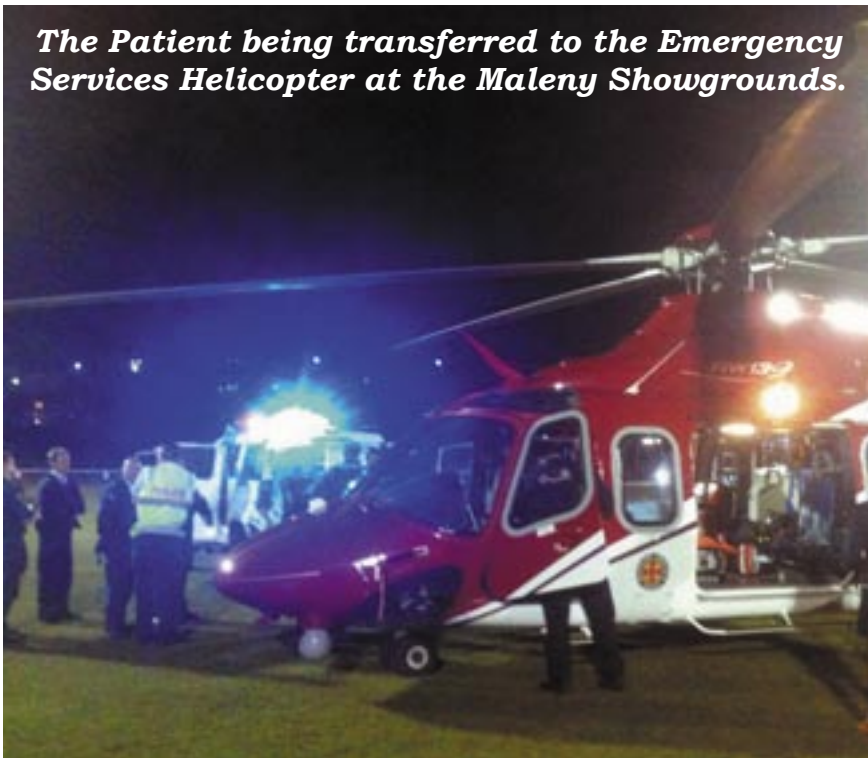
The Maleny SES Group was called in to assist in moving the casualty up a steep slippery heavily timbered hill that was only accessible by 4WD. This exercise took a number of ambulance officers and SES volunteers to complete the extradition.

The injured person was conveyed to the Maleny hospital where his condition was stabilised before being medivaced to the P.A. Hospital in Brisbane by Queensland Government helicopter where he was admitted in a critical condition.

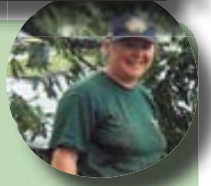
Unfortunately, this person passed away in hospital on August 5th from his injuries. The name of the injured person has been released as Brian William King.

Volunteer Community Education Officers now have access to a presentation called "Fire Ed Early Years" to assist in teaching younger people about fire safety.

The kit contains a DVD and a teachers resource kit which can be adapted to fit into normal school lessons.

In this program students learn about being a Fire Safe Family by having in their homes working smoke alarms. These should be tested each year on April 1st.

They also learn about the importance of safe escape plans which should have two escape exits.

Students are also taught the importance of knowing which emergency numbers to call - stickers for the home telephone for accurate address details are provided.

The program explains the importance of having a Fire blanket and fire extinguisher and how to use those items.

Acting safely around fire is instilled into the student. Following the completion of the course each student is presented with a Fire Safety Certificate by their teacher.

The Fire Service mascot, BLAZER is also involved in presenting this program to younger students. Towards the end of the program a fire appliance is also displayed.

The Butlers were one of the most outstanding of the Norman-Irish families. When Theobald Fitzwalter was created chief Butler of Ireland by Henry II in 1177 the family came to be known as Butler. As they grew in importance they were created Earls of Ormond, the most important of many titles conferred on them. From their fortress at Gowran and, later, Kilkenny castle, they feuded constantly with their neighbours and powerful rivals, the FitzGeralds, Earls of Kildare. Anne Boleyn, one of the wives of Henry VIII and mother of Elizabeth I, was of Butler descent. The famous poet, William Butler Yeates, was also a kinsman.

Bells Creek intersection to be closed

The Department of Main Roads has announced that the Bells Creek and Roys Road median access points will be closed along the Bruce Highway in the very near future. This is an effort to give this intersection greater safety.

This has come about as a result of a number of serious accidents at the intersection. This intersection is used by many Maleny residents who travel to Bells Creek to fish.

Member for Glass House, Andrew Powell said, “There’s no doubt that this will make the Highway safer. These intersections are notorious black spots. They’ve been slated for upgrades.”

These intersections, along with the Johnston Road interchange, were slated for upgrade under the Federal Government’s Nation Building Program. Following the floods in January 2011 the funds originally set aside for these projects was reallocated to assisting the flood recovery effort.

“Advice has now been given that the project has been reinstated and that works to upgrade will commence as soon as the design is completed. My focus continues to be the complete upgrade of these interchanges. I will continue to pressure both levels of Government to see these vital projects brought forward,” Mr Powell concluded.
