Petrol tanker crashes near Conondale

Emergency crews were called to the site of a crash involving a petrol tanker on the Maleny Kenilworth Road approximately two kilometers west of Conondale at about 12.30pm. on Tuesday October 18th.

Luckily the diesel mini-tanker did not erupt into flames as a result of it rolling onto its side after the driver lost control on a curve in the road.

The driver of the tanker, a 50 year old male received serious head injuries in this incident and was transported to the Royal Brisbane Hospital.

Following the accident he had trouble exiting the truck's cabin but was out by the time that emergency service crews arrived.

No other person was injured in this incident.

Local Dairy and milk processor, Maleny Dairies has recalled several of its products due to possible chemical contamination.

The products recalled are:
Maleny Dairies Low Fat Milk,
Full Cream Milk
and Farmers Choice
Guernsey Milk
with use-by
dates of October



24 and 25, Maleny Dairies Skim Milk with a use-by date of October 22, Maleny Dairies Chocolate, Coffee and Strawberry varieties with a use-by date of October 25 and Maleny Dairies Goats Milk with use-by dates of October 24 and 25.

A Maleny Dairies spokesperson said the products had been recalled after the business received several phone calls from customers, who complained of a "funny taste in the milk". The only chemicals used in the production line are food-grade cleaners and

sanitisers and testing to date has come up negative for those.

He continued, "Most of the calls were about low-fat milk with a use-by date of October 24."

Consumers can return any of the above products to the place of purchase for a full refund.

I must say that I have one of those products in my fridge and have noticed nothing different to normal. I will drink it.

Although Maleny received rain a week ago last Saturday morning from a thunderstorm conditions are still dry and the Fire Danger Rating remains HIGH.

The Maleny & District Rural Fire Brigade attended a fire call in North Maleny Road on Tuesday afternoon a week ago when a permitted hazard reduction burn escaped containment lines.

All 3 Maleny units responded and spent over 3 hours at this location. The QFRS spotter aircraft was on a return flight back to Caloundra for refuelling and diverted to Maleny and was able to pass on the the crews on the fire ground hotspots and rate of spread of the fire.

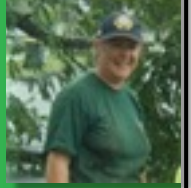
This fire created a lot of smoke which drifted over Maleny that afternoon.

The Maleny Relay for Life was held last Saturday and the Maleny Rurals and The TS Centaur Navy Cadets entered a combined Team of FIREWALKERS. Cancer never sleeps hence the Relay for life is an overnight team event. The money raised is used for Health education, investing in research and opening new Cancer Council offices with staff in communities to support people in these communities. The Cancer Council Queensland began in 1961 when 12 dedicated Queenslanders came together to do something about Cancer.

Look out for kids on bikes

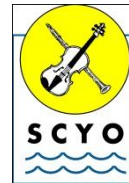
If you carry a passenger and they are not seated on a passenger seat you risk being fined \$40.

Mum's Favourite Recipe Easy Fried Rice!

Ingredients:

- 1 cup long grain white rice * 2 eggs
- 2 teaspoons vegetable oil * 1/2 cup frozen peas, thawed
- 2 bacon rashers, chopped * 1 carrot, peeled and grated
- 2 shallots, trimmed, finely sliced
- 1 tablespoon soy sauce, plus extra to serve

Directions

1. Cook the rice in a large saucepan of boiling water for 12 minutes or until tender. Drain and leave to cool.
2. Using a whisk, lightly beat eggs in a small bowl. Heat oil in non-stick wok or large frying pan over medium heat. Add eggs. Swirl over base to form an omelette. Cook 2 minutes. Turn over. Cook 2 minutes until set. Transfer to a chopping board. Set aside to cool slightly. Cut into short strips.
3. Add bacon to wok. Cook 4 minutes until light golden. Add carrot. Stir fry 1 minute. Add shallots, peas and rice. Cook, stirring, 3-4 minutes. Add egg and soy sauce. Stir until heated through. Serve immediately, with extra soy.

Parents can help by recommending the Navy Cadets to their friends who have children of the right age.

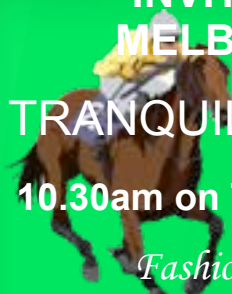
