Local Federal member in dispute with his electoral chairman

Local Federal member for Fisher, Mr. Peter Slipper is at loggerheads with the LNP Fisher Electoral Chairman Mr. Mal Brough following an invitation issued by Mr. Mal Brough to members of the LNP Fisher Electorate members to be held at the Big Barrel Winery, Landsborough Road, Maleny on Friday December 9th, 2011.

The invitation was issued under Mr. Brough's name on behalf of the LNP Fisher Electorate and replies were to be directed back to a business email that was not associated with the Fisher Electorate office.

Mr. Slipper is quoted as saying that he was not consulted by Mr. Brough before organising the event.

Mr. Brough was easily elected to the position of LNP Electoral Chairman of Fisher in what was seen as a takeover of the LNP Electoral Committee at a heated meeting in Maleny on September 3rd, 2011. Mr. Brough is expected to seek the LNP nomination for the Fisher Federal seat at the next election.

As a result of the invitation issued to attend the Christmas event Mr. Slipper has called for Mr. Brough to be expelled from the LNP on the grounds of creating an "unacceptable and destructive" situation within the electorate.

The matter was exacerbated by the publication of an electorate newsletter which was sent to all members of the LNP Fisher electorate.

The newsletter contained a letter from the Electorate Committee Chairman Mr. Mal Brough and an introduction to the committee members elected at the September 3rd AGM at the Maleny Community Centre.

Mr. Slipper said that at the AGM only the positions of chairman, deputy chairman, secretary and treasurer were filled but now four other positions on the executive have been filled without the members being voted into those positions and those members are now making decisions relating to the housing and development business forum and other initiatives mentioned in the newsletter.

Mr. Slipper said, "This newsletter was prepared and sent out without any reference to me."

When asked if he had had a reply from the Queensland LNP Mr. Slipper said, "I have been advised that the matter is under consideration, but no decision has been made at this time."

At the time that these matters are being aired within the elector-

ate Mr. Slipper invited the Foreign Minister, Mr. Kevin Rudd into the electorate where he visited the Kawana State College. This visit came at a time when on the same day former Liberal Prime Minister John Howard launches John Connolly's campaign for the state seat of Nambour, ahead of elections due early next year.

Mr. Slipper said, "The timing of these visits were purely coincidental as the dates had to fit in with Mr. Rudd's diary."

At the same time the LNP Member for Fairfax Alex Somlyay is sniping from the sidelines by calling on Mr. Slipper to step down saying, "It's time for a fresh start for the Sunshine Coast. Peter can't work with anyone to the north or south of his

seat."

Following a meeting of the LNP State Executive convened to discuss this matter on November 23rd a LNP spokesperson said, "Whilst realising the seriousness of this matter the state executive will undertake additional consultation and seek further input from relevant parties before convening to discuss the matter again."

On November 24th in a dramatic twist the Speaker of the Federal Parliament, Mr. Harry Jenkins has suddenly resigned the position of Speaker.

The Federal Member for Fisher, Mr. Peter Slipper will be the replacement. This will mean that the federal government will be required to obtain one less vote for bills to be passed through the parliament.

It is anticipated that due to the fact that the opposition had at an

urgent meeting on the morning of November 24th agreed not to provide a member to take on the Speaker's position that Mr. Slipper would resign from the LNP in order to take the position.

All attempts to contact Mr. Slipper's electoral office on the morning of November 24th were unsuccessful so no comments could be obtained.

Inquiries of Mr. Mal Borough also met with no results although he has agreed to send answers to written questions, however those comments were not available at this time.

The only thing for sure is that there is bound to be turmoil not only in the Fisher electoral office but within the ranks of the LNP Headquarters over the next week as the real position is ascertained.

Once again the voters in the Fisher electorate are left in limbo.

Local Mayoral Candidate withdraws

Local popular Mayoral Candidate, Winston Johnston has officially withdrawn from the 2012 Mayoral race.

Winston who previously was a councillor for Division 1 of the former Caloundra City Council from 1982 until 1991 had originally signalled his intention to stand as a candidate for Mayor of the Sunshine Coast Regional Council as he was concerned that there did not appear to be candidates that could handle the business of Australia's fastest growing regional area.

Mr. Johnston said, "Since I first considered running there have been a number of candidates who have "put up their hands" and the electorate now has a number of candidates from whom to make a choice."

The next election for the Mayor position as well as the twelve divisional councillors is on the 31st March, 2012. Maleny and the surrounding areas is in Division 5 which is presently represented by Cr. Jenny McKay who holds the Portfolio of "Community Policy and Programs portfolio"

One of our readers suggested that we should have a quick refresher of some of those rules.

The most dangerous thing about travelling in a motor vehicle is still the "NUT BEHIND THE WHEEL".



Stopping for twin red lights (except at level crossings)

(1) A driver approaching or at twin red lights on a road (except at a level crossing) must stop in accordance with subsections (2) and (3).

Maximum penalty—20 penalty units.

(2) If there is a stop line at or near the lights and the driver can stop safely before reaching the stop line, the driver must stop as near as practicable to, but before reaching, the stop line.

(3) If there is no stop line at or near the lights and the driver can stop safely before reaching the lights, the driver must stop as near as practicable to, but before reaching, the lights.

(4) If the driver stops for the lights, the driver must not proceed until the lights are not showing.

Mum's favourite Recipes BBQ Pork Steaks



Ingredients

- * 1 1/2 Tablespoons Hungarian paprika * 1 teaspoon salt
- * 1 Tablespoon ground coriander
- * 1 Tablespoon finely grated lemon zest (zest from 1 lemon)
- * 1 Tablespoon dried marjoram * 2 teaspoons garlic powder
- * 3/4 teaspoon freshly ground black pepper
- * 1/2 teaspoon ground cumin
- * 1/4 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- * 1/4 teaspoon caraway seeds, crushed
- * 8 boneless pork shoulder steaks, cut 3/4-inch thick

Directions

In a small bowl combine paprika, coriander, lemon zest, marjoram, garlic powder, salt, pepper, cumin, caraway seeds, and cinnamon.

Rub herb mixture on both sides of steaks, pressing into surface. Place steaks in center of cooking grate.

Grill 10 minutes for medium (160 degrees F) or 12 to 14 minutes for well-done (170 degrees F), turning once halfway through grilling time.

Prepare your home for storms!



It has been suggested by the Bureau of Meteorology that the 2011 - 2012 summer season has a 60 - 75% chance of not only having above average rainfall but damaging storms.

Now is a great time to prepare your home and surrounds so that you are best able to survive those storms.

Some of the things that should be checked as part of a general home maintenance check before storms are imminent.

- Check the condition of the roof and repair loose tiles, eaves and roof screws;
- Clean gutters and downpipes so water can drain away as quickly as possible;
- Trim trees and overhanging branches;
- and
- Secure loose items around your property and garden that could cause damage if blown around in high winds (such as garden furniture and toys).

Origin & Arms of
The Family Name



The family name Berry is most usually known as an English variant of the topographic or habitation name Bury from the Old English burh meaning 'fortified place'. In Ireland it is the Anglicised form of the Gaelic *O Beargha* or 'descendant of Beargh', a byname meaning 'robber'. It is also known as a French regional name for someone who came from Berry, a former province of central France, apparently a derivative of a Gaulic personal name, *Boirius* or *Barius*. Variant of the French name include *Berrier*, *Berryer*, *Berruer*, *Berruex* and *Berruex*.
